SAFETY GUIDELINES

We are doing everything we can to keep our kids safe and appreciate your help & understanding during this season!

Below are a series of steps that Mid-Way Baptist Church has and will continue taking to prepare for our current health precautions:

- All Church Volunteers and Teachers will be wearing masks for your family's protection and in accordance with government protocols.
- All Church Volunteers, Teachers, Children and Parents that arrive for drop-off and pick-up will have their temperatures checked upon arrival.
- Minimized number of chairs to assist with disinfecting during and after teaching sessions.
- We will provide individual cubbie boxes of supplies for each child: scissors, markers, glue sticks, etc., to minimize sharing.
- Volunteers are to always use gloves when handing out pre-packaged snacks & juice boxes.

Q & A

1. What are your procedures for registering children as they come to the children's area?

- Masks are mandatory for ALL adults who enters the hallway. This includes parents dropping their child off. This is to ensure protection of our children and we greatly appreciate your understanding.
- Same staffer registering guests on check in device
- Only 1 parent permitted for drop off/pick up
- Limited number of entrances and exits.
- If you forgot your mask, one will be provided for you during check in.

2. Will you perform temperature checks before allowing children and parents to enter?

- Yes. We have no-touch forehead thermometers and each child and parent will be checked before entrance is permitted.
- Temperatures must be below 100 degrees F.

3. Will people (adults and children) be required to wash hands upon arrival?

- Hand Sanitizing dispensers are provided during check in and in the Gym for all in attendance.
- Every volunteer will wash hands upon arrival before children arrive.

4. Will people (adults and children) be required to wear masks?

- Every child over the age of 5 is encouraged to wear a mask before entering the hallway. If you do not have a mask for your child, one will be available for them at check in.
- All adults who enter the hallway are required to wear a mask. If you do not have a mask, one will be available for you.
- For parents dropping their child off, only the parent checking in will be required to wear a mask while in the Children's Drop Off hallway.
